Hello everyone!

My name is Rohit Dhir, and I am excited for the opportunity to introduce myself and my practice to the group. Thanks to Dr. Jignesh Shah for reaching out to me.

For those of you who do not know me, I am a board-certified Urological Surgeon who sees patients in the Clear Lake area. I earned both my undergraduate and medical degrees from Georgetown University during tenure in Washington, DC. I then served as chief resident during my Urological residency at the University of Texas at Houston / MD Anderson Cancer Center, in addition to completing my internship in general surgery.

I have been in private practice for 7 years now in the Houston area. In November of 2019, I founded HTX Urology and am now busier than ever. My clinical focus includes minimally-invasive surgical therapy for BPH, leading-edge Men's Health, and comprehensive kidney stone treatment and prevention strategies.

This year, HTX Urology was selected as one of only three Centers of Excellence in the greater Houston area for the UroLift System, a validated in-office procedural substitute for TURP with equivalent outcomes and much lower morbidity. I am also active in clinical research involving newer surgical techniques to treat BPH with the goal of maximizing bladder health and de-prescribing medications that carry risks of long-term toxicity. Additionally, I provide non-surgical management of erectile dysfunction using low-intensity shockwave therapy as well as testosterone replacement.

I live in the Memorial area of Houston with my wife Reena who works in commercial real estate. We love our son Aryan (2) and our old grumpy dog Robster (12) who we adopted over a decade ago. I enjoy music, finance, love a great cut of steak, and am a diehard Green Bay Packers fan (I grew up in Milwaukee, WI).

I look forward to clinical collaboration and networking with you all. As you may know, there is a shortage of Urologists nationwide and it can often be difficult for your patients to wait weeks and sometimes months to be seen. It is my goal to see any new patient needing help in under one week. I offer convenient online scheduling via my website. Alternatively, do not hesitate to reach out via cell or email for help. 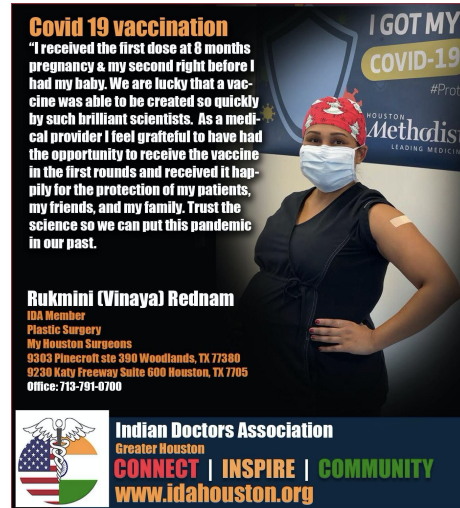

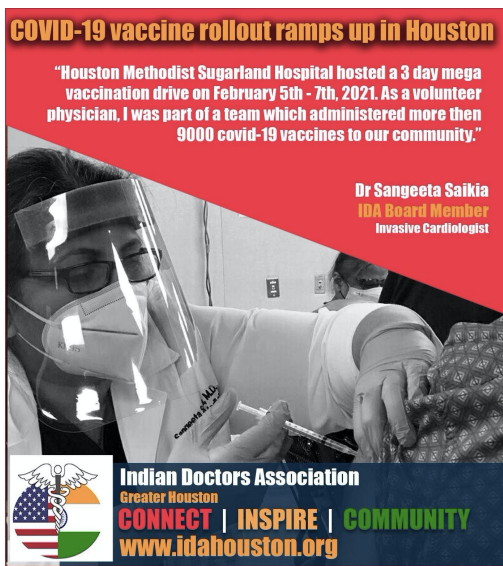

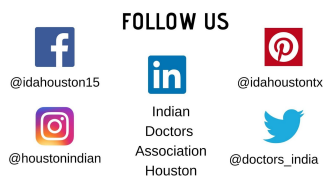
