India Ministry of Culture: Manas Wildlife Sanctuary



Located in the foothills of the Himalayas, which give way to tropical forests and alluvial grasslands, the Manas Wildlife Sanctuary is teeming with diverse fauna. These include endangered species like Indian rhinoceros, Indian elephant, tiger and pygmy hog. Some of the other animals you can spot include golden langurs, bison, deer, red panda etc. The sanctuary offers

amazing opportunities for birdwatching as well. You can spot avifauna like Bengal florican, great pied hornbill, wreathed hornbill, greater adjutant, and many more. Since the park is watered by the Manas river, aquatic life flourishes richly in it.
