

Hardinge Medical College in New
Delhi, India. She completed her
Internal Medicine residence at The

Galveston in 2007, followed by her

and Metabolism in 2009, when she

Over the course her career, she has cared for her patients at the Endocrine & Psychiatry Center in Houston from 2009 to 2011. 

- 2.) Health Screening for basic checkup after the health promotion talk during the health camps.



Sri Madhusudhan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research: India's First Private Free Medical College





We feature here India's first free private rural medical college. Alerted by one of our members Dr. Rupa Mahadevan, I have had the honor of learning about this amazing initiative through Dr. Rupa Mahadevan's father, Mr. Vivek Mahadevan. Mr. Vivek Mahadevan is on the board of One World, One Family (https://oneworldonefamily.foundation/index.html) that has an area of investment to create a world where free education is provided to all. Under this mission, a free medical school was set up and inaugurated recently. In his words, 'Vaidyo Narayano Harihi' – The Doctor is verily the embodiment of the Divine. The human body is a thing of marvelous beauty, and it is doctors who are bestowed to better understand this Divine Miracle."

The Medical College was inaugurated in March 2023 by the Honorable Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi and shall provide value based medical education, inspiring youth to serve society and contribute towards Universal Health, with love and compassion as the guiding tenets. With a focus on rural India and to provide the fundamental right to education, this Medical College will nurture medical doctors with noble values, who will dedicate themselves to serve the underserved, particularly in rural India. By making it accessible and affordable for all, irrespective of financial means, it will ensure that every deserving candidate will be able to pursue medical education. The goal of this strategy is with a hope that the beneficiaries will perceive the need and try their best to offer back to societal welfare and return to their villages and serve the pockets of the population residing in the villages which are in deep need of quality healthcare.

The students of this one-of-its-kind medical college should be equipped with brilliant heads, compassionate hearts and skillful hands. In view of this, medical education at Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research is a compulsory residential program, wherein knowledge is imparted as values-based medical education. In recent news, The Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (SMSIMS&R), in rural Karnataka, has posted a 100% pass rate with all 50 students scoring the coveted First-Class marks with 39 out of 50 students scoring Distinctions. This is a landmark achievement, a national record for any medical college in India!
